### **Professional Equipment** And Facilities

The space and facilities dedicated to graduate study truly set MICA apart from other colleges of art and universitybased programs. Each graduate program has its own space appropriate to student needs, including individual studios and personalized work stations. MICA also offers one of the best visual arts libraries in the nation. Computers, servers, equipment, and software are continually upgraded to serve artists working at an advanced level. The technical needs of graduate students and faculty are met with an expansive Graduate Research Lab, prototyping and fabrication labs, a metal shop, wood shops, 3D printers, 3D scanners, laser cutters, and computer-controlled milling machines.

### **Visiting Artist Lecture Series**

The Graduate Visiting Artist Lecture Series provides students with opportunities to learn from and interact with artists, designers, and critics across disciplines and practices. Each week, these outstanding professionals give public talks, engage in small class seminars, critique students' work in the studios, provide models for professional success, and share meals with students and faculty in the neighborhoods surrounding MICA.






