Late Arrival Policy:

MFA and MA students are expected to arrive on campus for all required Graduate Orientation activities beginning Tuesday, August 22, 2023, which is essential to being well prepared for the first week of classes and the start of the Fall 2023 semester. However, as global conditions continue to constrain travel, we recognize some students may be prevented from arriving on time. The final date for MFA and MA student late arrival to campus, without disruption to a student's academic standing, is Friday, September 8th. This is also the last day

a student can withdraw from the College with a 100% refund according to MICA policy.
