



Amygdalus kansuensis is a native plant of China, distributed in central and western provinces such as shaanxi, gansu, qinghai, hubei and sichuan. The local people call the gansu peach the "three unlike", which means the fruit is neither like the wild peach, nor like the mountain peach and apricot. Gansu peach is a wild relative of the famous fruit "peach". Its flowers are white to pale pink, open in early spring and full of flowers. It is also a beautiful ornamental plant and nectar plant. Although the seed kernel of gansu peach can be used as medicine, it has not been included in the "Chinese pharmacopoeia", but in shaanxi, the seed kernel as a traditional Chinese medicine "peach kernel" has been purchased and used, is a local customary medicine. Gansu peach is very tolerant to drought, resistance to barrenness, fruit pests and diseases less, flowers dense, can be used as breeding materials.
