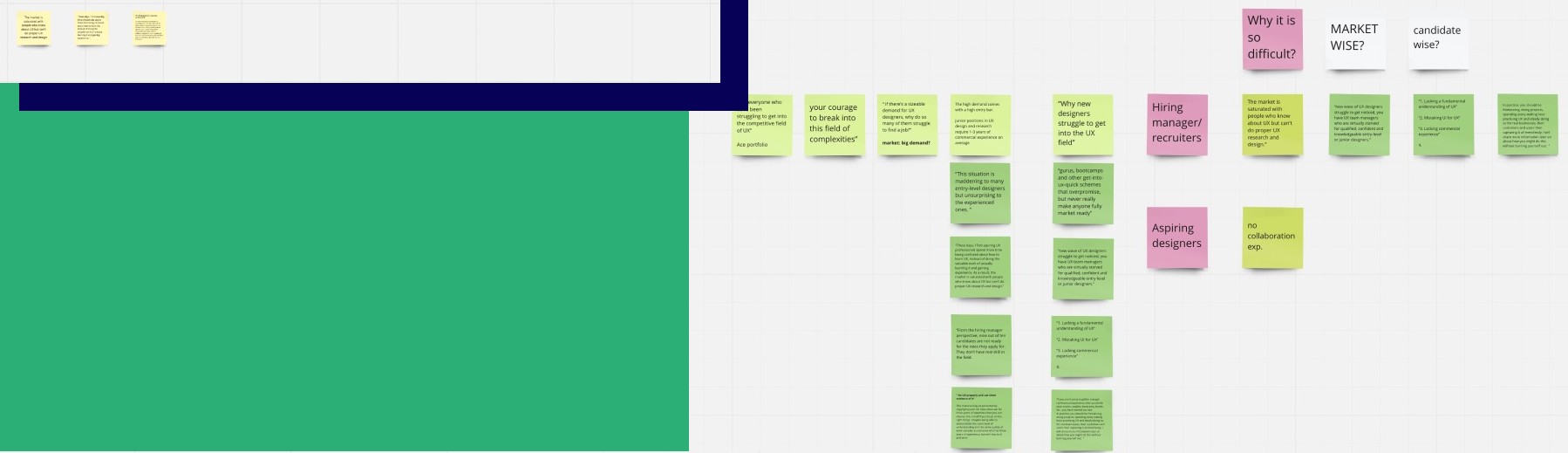
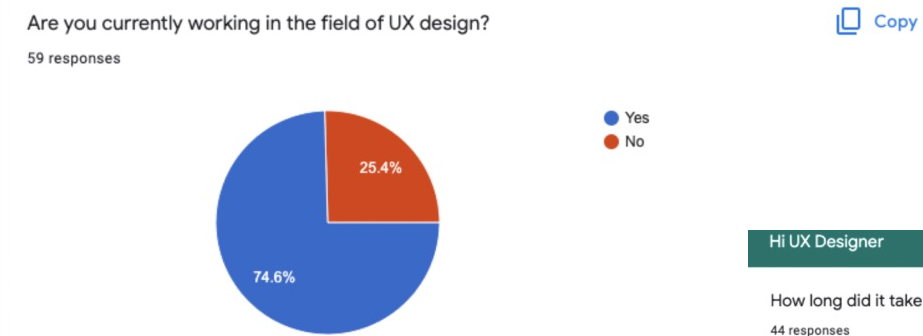
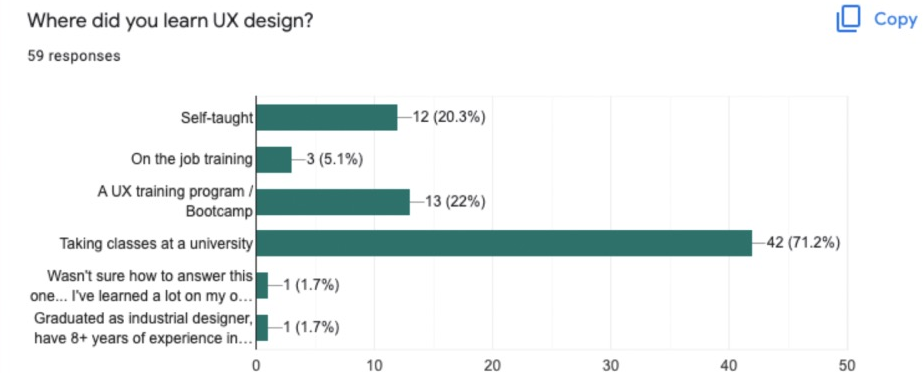
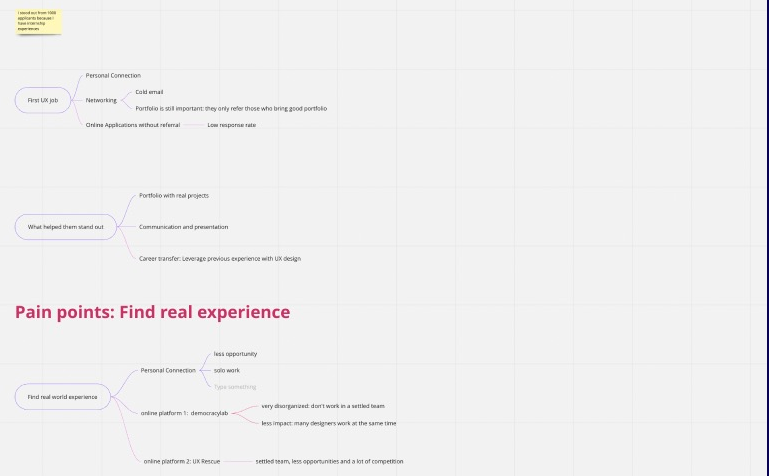
Experience

The market is saturated with people who know about UX but can't do proper UX research and design

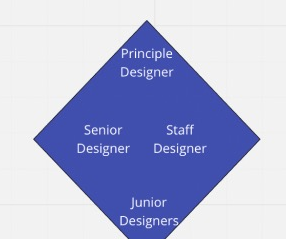
Portfolio is the starting point of everything. Real projects help them gain more interview opportunities: find resources, collaborate with stakeholders
